

English

In English we will be focusing on Non-fiction forms of writing by writing a newspaper report based on the festival of Holi. We will also continue our learning about poetry by creating an acrostic poem about the festival of Holi.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing our learning of addition and subtraction methods by extending our number knowledge to 20. We will then focus on learning Place value to 50.

Science

In science we will be identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will be splatting body parts with paint!

DT

In DT we will be using the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes.

We will also learn to understand where food comes from and celebrate this with a cultural day.

Geography
