

## Maths

In Maths we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction, statistics, multiplication and division and perimeter and area. We will link our Maths to our topic learning, for example; rounding distances between Ipswich and islands, plotting and comparing rainfall and temperature on different islands.



## English

In English we will be focusing on writing to entertain and inform. We will be imitating, innovating and inventing our own character descriptions, narratives, recounts and non-chronological reports. We will be inspired by 'The Island', 'The Wreck of the Zanzibar' and Sir David Attenborough.

## Science

Stranded on our island, we will learn how to filter water, test materials for their permeability to build our own shelters and group and compare them based on their properties. We will look at different islands to compare living things and their habitats, including life cycles and reproduction. This will be inspired by David Attenborough's documentaries.

## Music

Inspired by Pirates of the Caribbean, we will be looking at how music affects the mood of the listener. We will also be looking at Music through time, considering how we can use our own voices effectively to compose our own music.



## Physical Education

Transferring our team skills from PSHE, we will be orienteering outdoors and learning how to read maps. We will also be learning how to play Netball and our own 'Castle Hill Games'.

## French
