

Maths

In Maths we will focus on multiplying 4-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers and dividing with remainders. We will then move on to adding and subtracting fractions, finding fractions of amounts and using fractions as operators.



English

In English we will be learning and writing our own poems using rhyming couplets. We will focus on writing to inform, persuade and discuss through writing newspaper articles, non-chronological reports, persuasive letters and balanced arguments.

Science

Landing in Central America and starting with the Mayans view of astronomy we will be delving into our topic on space. This will include our place in the solar system, the movement of the sun, the moon and how the Earth's rotation gives us day and night.



Music

Inspired by Mayan sounds we will be learning to use various wind instruments to create our own Mayan style music.

Within this term we will be doing Gymnastics, Swimming and competitive games.
