

Maths

In maths we will be embedding or understanding of place value with numbers up to 1000.

The children will be challenged to solve addition and subtraction problems.



French



We will learn how to greet each other and ask how someone is feeling? The children will learn the number names and the days of the week.

PE

This term we will be learning the different passes in Netball and we will begin to play a game focussing on defending and attacking.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be focussing on and building relationships through Our Time activities



Cooking

Bread became an important part of the Stone Age diet. We will be making bread and exploring how the techniques have changed.

Music



In music we will explore different composers such as Benjamin Britten and explore how to make music like our ancestors from the Stone Age. The children will learn songs about the Stone Age.

English

This term we will be learning how to be Journalists and will produce our own newspaper reports.

We will become an author and make up our own stories about the Stone Age. Using the small world tray we will develop our story telling skills and focus on our use of descriptive language.



Science

In Science we will be looking at the human skeleton, identifying the different bones and their jobs. We will be learning that animals including humans need food to stay alive and we will discuss the importance of the balanced diets. We will look at the food chain and compare our diets and needs to that of our ancestors allowing us to see how it has changed.



Computing

We will focus on E-safety and Cyber Bullying ensuring the children are aware of how to stay safe while using the computer.

The children will be taught how to use search engines and find reliable sources so that they can carry out research for themselves.

We will also be learning how to use Power Point and exploring the different features so that the children can produce their own Power Point to share with their parents at their workshop.

Walking in Our Ancestors' Footsteps

Stone Age – Iron Age

Geography



We will be learning about what is needed to make an area good for building a settlement. We will look at how Britain became an island and how the land has changed since the Stone Age.

History



In history we will be learning about how our ancestors' lives changed dramatically because of the introduction of farming. The children will be taught about the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic periods and the developments that took place between Stone Age – Iron Age

Art and Design



In art we will be exploring materials such as pastels, paint, charcoal, chalk etc. and exploring how we can apply them on paper to create the desired effect we want.

We will be using the cave painting found from the Stone Age as a stimulus to produce our own cave paintings and we will recreate the Hand Prints found in a cave in Argentina.

Design Technology

In DT we will link our learning to our geography and create a small world Stone Age settlement thinking about human and physical features. We will design and make our features for the settlement.

Children will design and make Stone Age tools for our Workshop. They will need to cut the wood down using tools safely.
